I have received your consultation Email as we were the first National Park Parish to have a NHP and one of the initial tranche of NHP's across the country.

I have one major observation on NHP's. Make sure you have a Local Plan in place BEFORE you adopt an NHP. The Lyn Plan has just been usurped and is now merely advisory because Exmoor National Park had no Local Plan and the one going through now, if adopted, will overturn previous plans including our NHP. This despite ENPA trying to reference the Lyn Plan in the ENPA Local Plan.

The Govt inspector rejected all argument to achieve this sadly.
